RE: Remembrance Day 11.11.24

Wadham School will once again be commemorating Remembrance Day.

Our day will begin with a Remembrance Service, supported by Reverend Stephen Gray from the Crewkerne Community Church during assembly time. Year 7 students, as well as representatives from student leadership will take part in the service, which will involve the laying of the wreath at our memorial boards in the Hall. The service will be live streamed to tutor rooms so that all students can watch this event.

Bells will be rung at 11.00am on Tuesday 11th November, so that our school community can observe the 2 minutes silence. Bells will ring again to mark the end of the silence and continuation of morning break.

We strongly encourage all staff and students to be wearing poppies during this important national event. Poppies are available, for a donation, from the Hub during break and lunch. Prefects have also been visiting tutor groups in the morning to enable students and staff to donate and receive their poppy.

Please do encourage your child to purchase their poppy and to wear it with pride. All money raised goes to the Royal British Legion, which provides lifelong support for the Armed Forces community - serving men and women, veterans, and their families.

Students who take part in cadets outside of school are encouraged to wear their cadet uniform for the full day on Tuesday 11th November.
