



Dear Parents / Guardians,

At the beginning of March there was a gathering of young people in Crewkerne town centre. Police received numerous reports of anti-social behaviour, an allegation of a serious assault and one of a sexual offence. The investigation into these matters is ongoing.

Because of this incident two people have been interviewed under police caution and numerous Anti-Social Behaviour letters have been served on young people and their parents.

People travelled from surrounding towns and out of county to this event which was advertised on social media.

Large unauthorised gatherings can cause significant concern in the local community and put young people at risk.

It has been brought to the attention of the police that there is another similar event planned during May half term.

I would urge all parents to ensure that they speak to their child regarding attending such events, the consequences of attending and potential risks of large gatherings.
