Amendments to our Behaviour Policy

With new routines and expectations now established, we have reviewed our Behaviour Policy and are introducing an amendment from this term to our procedure for managing and resolving truancy from lessons.

A reminder to parents that we have introduced movement time between all lessons and use corridor passes so that students can access toilets during the day. This means that students that do not arrive on time to lessons without valid reason are deemed as truanting (choosing to miss) learning – there simply is no reason to be late.

From this term, students found to be truanting will be placed in their lesson rather than taken to ISR. Although this may cause a little disruption, we have seen a significant reduction in the number of students choosing to truant during the day, such that positive attendance to lessons is now the norm.

Students that choose to truant will still receive an after-school detention (set for the following day) and all other expectations regarding Behaviour for Learning remain unchanged.

We have updated classroom posters and briefed students of this change when they returned last week and are confident that it will have a positive impact on learning and outcomes.


Addams Family Values – Tickets on Sale Now!
