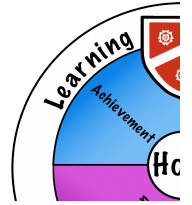

RE: Year 7 Maths Trip to Taunton Racecourse – Thursday 27th November

The Maths Department is delighted to invite your child to take part in an exciting Maths trip to Taunton Racecourse on Thursday 27th November, organised by Racing to School.

Racing to School is an educational charity that inspires young minds through free, interactive, and healthy outdoor learning events at a variety of racing venues across Great Britain. Their activities link classroom learning to real-world applications in numeracy, literacy, and science, offering pupils a unique opportunity to see how mathematics is used in the sport of horseracing and beyond.

A group of 30 Year 7 students will participate in a range of practical and engaging sessions led by experienced Racing to School staff, including former jockeys who have retrained as education officers.

The coach will depart Wadham School at 8:45 a.m. and return by 3:00 p.m. Students should wear full school uniform with sensible outdoor footwear and bring a packed lunch, a drink, and any necessary medication.

The cost of the trip is £10 per student, covering transport and participation in the day's activities. Payment should be made via iPayimpact no later than Friday 7th November (we can only take 30 students on this trip so if you have not paid by this date we will open the trip up to other students).
