Dear Parents and Carers,

Re: Headteacher's Update 20.03.23

We continue to make good ground in all areas, and despite the disruption schools have faced nationally, the overwhelming majority of Wadham students should feel pleased with their response to these, and other challenges.

There will always be mixed opinions regarding decisions made and action taken, the response to recent industrial action being a good example, and I do hope that in this regard, people feel that they have been heard. We have certainly tried our best to maintain a routine of quality education.

The Church of England's Vision for Education speaks of 'community' and living well together, of dignity and respect. We believe in courageous advocacy and engagement with big issues, big questions. Schools and parishes are such important places for promoting and modelling these values; developing emotional literacy skills, learning how to listen, to share and how to disagree well when this is appropriate.

We all have different perspectives, thoughts and voices. In the New Testament, written at a time where there were many deep differences of perspective, thoughts and voices, Jesus reminded us to go back to those basics, to love God and love your neighbour as yourself. Surely, part of that love is to notice a fellow human being, to listen and hear the voices of others, especially of the most vulnerable or marginalised. Surely part of that love is to be informed and courageous in responses, challenging respectfully, welcoming respectful challenge, always grounded in love and dignity. There have been some very good examples of this in recent weeks!

A thought for this week is simply, 'who's voice do you hear, and how are you responding?'

Under the Stairs is Out of Bounds!


- We've taped to show where students can't go!
