RE: Maths Inspiration Lecture – Bath (5th March 2026)

We are pleased to inform you that Year 11 pupils and Year 10 Further Mathematics pupils have the opportunity to attend a Maths Inspiration Lecture at the Forum in Bath on Thursday 5th March 2026.

This event is designed to inspire students, show the real-world impact of mathematics, and support their progress in GCSE and Further Maths.

The lecture programme features three engaging speakers:

Colin Wright – “Patterns, Predictions and Juggling”,

Ben Sparks – “Windmills of Your Mind”, and

Alison Kiddle – “One in a Million.”

Timetable for the day

Students will attend Periods 1 and 2 as normal. After break, they will meet in the Main Hall, and we will depart school at 11:30am.

The lecture runs from 1:15pm to 3:45pm. We will eat lunch before the event and after the event, students will have approximately one hour in Bath to buy food and refreshments. We will leave Bath at 5:00pm, arriving back at school at approximately 6:30pm. Students will need to make their own way home from school at that time.

Cost and booking

The total cost of the trip, which includes coach transport and lecture tickets, is £29.

We have 30 places available, which will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. The trip will go live to book on iPayimpact at 6:00pm on Thursday 22nd January.
