



Monday 17th July and Tuesday 18th July

Option 1

One night camping at a local scout camp (Near Taunton) with 4 activities.

Food: A packed lunch will be required for the first day.

Monday evening BBQ provided (or Alternative)

Cereal and pack lunch for Tuesday 18th July will be provided.

Students will need to provide their own tents etc in groups of 2+ (Max 4)

Further information will be provided to the students taking this option.

This information will include packing list etc.

There are two cost options for this activity

Option A: £50. For this option transport to and from the camp is not provided by Wadham. (Arrival time and pick up time will be communicated)

Optional Payment Plan: Deposit £30 and 2 payments of £10

Option B: £80. For this option students will be transported to and from the camp by Wadham. (Travel to and from school on Monday 17th July and Tuesday 18th July can be done using a student's normal mode of transport.)

Optional Payment Plan: Deposit £40 and 2 payments of £20

Option 2

Daily transport and activities at the scout camp above in option 1. (No overnight stay)

Depending on the number of students who choose this option, transport times 3 or 4 activities over the two days.

Cost £50

(This reflects the cost of transport as well as the daily activities)

Optional Payment Plan: Deposit £30 and 2 payments of £10

Option 3

School based activities.—Arrival for normal school days Monday 17th July and Tuesday 18th July.

Cost £0—More information will be provided about the activities at a later date.
