Intent: Students are offered a rich SOW that emphasises the importance of power and influence of those that have it. Beyond this students will gain an understanding of how beliefs and attitudes shape peoples approach to world around them and the way they react to it. The aim of the various units is to build upon some of the key skills that students gained in KS3, this will help their successfully study history at KS4. This also encompasses the need for positive relationships and how this is partly born out of respect. Finally, much of the learning gives an appreciation of the importance of relationships, respect for others and belonging; importantly this helps students adapt to modern society from learning of the past.
