

Tuesday 16th July ~ Thursday 18th July

#### **Option 1**

Two nights camping at a Huish Woods Scout camp (Near Taunton) with 9 activities.

Food and the activities are included in the costthis will be a fully catered event.

#### Students will need to provide their own tents etc in groups of 2+ (Max 4)

Further information will be provided to the students taking this option. This information will include packing list, dietary requirements, etc.

There are **two** cost options for this activity

#### **Option 1 A - £120**

For this option transport to and from the camp is not provided by Wadham. (Arrival time and pick up time will be communicated)

**Optional Payment Plan:** Deposit £60 and 2 further payments of £30

#### **Option 1 B - £135**

For this option students **will be** transported to and from the camp by Wadham. (Travel to and from school on Tuesday 16th July and Thursday 18th July can be done using a student's normal mode of transport.)

**Optional Payment Plan:** Deposit £75 and 2 further payments of £30

#### **Option 2**

School based activities.—Arrival for normal school days Tuesday 16th July to Thursday 18th July.

Cost £0—More information will be provided about the activities at a later date.

This will be some external run trips available at a cost as options for school based students (approx projection £45 per offsite activity).
