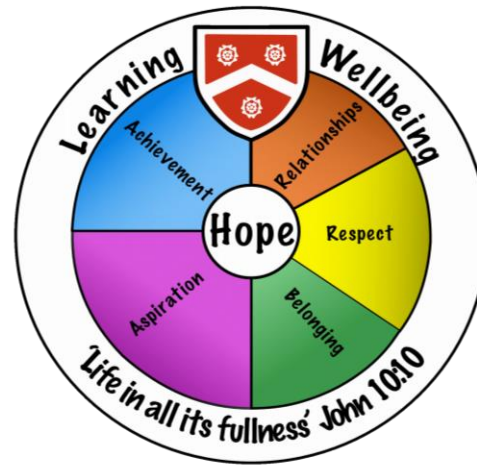


Our Vision
