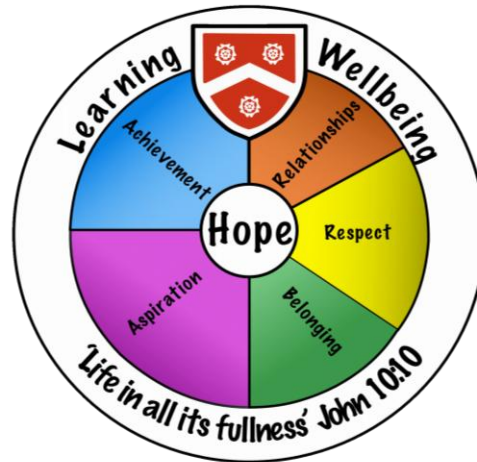


Our Vision
