We are delighted that your child will be joining us in September. On behalf of Wadham School I would like to extend a warm welcome and we look forward to working with you to make sure they have a happy and successful experience. In addition to achieving academic success, we want them to be able to benefit from and contribute to the rich cultural life of the school.

A number of things will be happening over the next few months to ensure that the smooth transfer to secondary education is a positive experience. Wadham staff will be visiting your child's current school, talking to teachers and finding out more about them as a person and a learner.

Should your child have additional needs Miss Davidson (SENCO), Mrs Charles (Deputy SENCO) and Mrs Guppy (Deputy SENCO) will be meeting with the SEND teams in your child's school to ensure we have support in place for them in September. Some children may benefit from an enhanced transition experience, and we will be working with our primary feeders to identify anyone where this additional support is required, contacting families directly to move this forward.

In the meantime, our Transition Team are busy preparing your 'Welcome!' pack, which contains all the information and paperwork you need to enrol your child with us ahead of September. Mrs Finch is our Transition Lead, and she will be writing to you before Easter to introduce herself and the Pastoral Team. This letter will also include your 'Welcome!' pack and we hope you find it useful in reading this information with your child so that as a family you are aware of the ethos, values and expectations of the school.
